

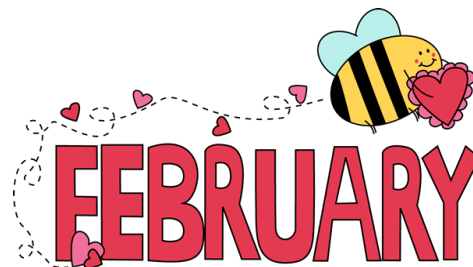

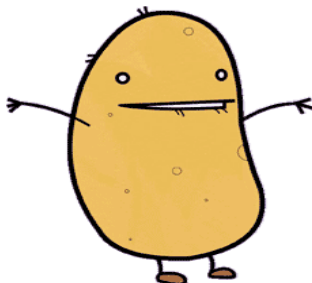

### MEN'S BREAKFAST

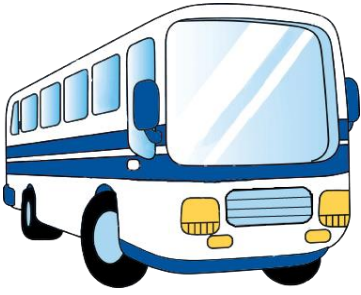

## FROM THE OPEN BOARD MEETING, 1/17/18\*

- \*Seven letters were read.
- \*Pat announced that Joanie Mauger is now a Highlands' employee; no longer works for Account Temps.
- \*There is a "no cash" policy in the office.
- \*All contracts are current.
- \*The pool heater has been replaced. It will cost \$949 to repair the old one as a backup.
- \*Three contractors liked our plans (copies on bulletin boards) for a handicapped bathroom; we are still waiting for bids.
- \*A CPA is in the process of reviewing our records.
- \*The proposal to raise the title transfer fee from \$100 to \$200 was voted down.
- \*The proposal to raise maintenance fees \$6 a month was tabled.
- \*Bernie stated it will cost more than \$40,000 to coat our roads and seal the cracks.
- \*We will begin updating the Pet Policy in February.
- \*Bernie motioned that the Board approve \$2900 to purchase gravel for around the clubhouse and easements and \$900 to have the tiles around the pool cleaned.
- \*The Social Committee will look into purchasing a ping-pong table to replace the damaged one.
