

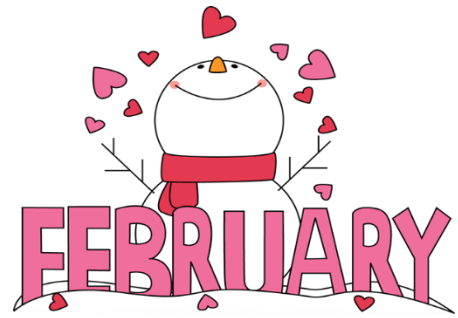

### INTERNATIONAL LUNCH GROUP

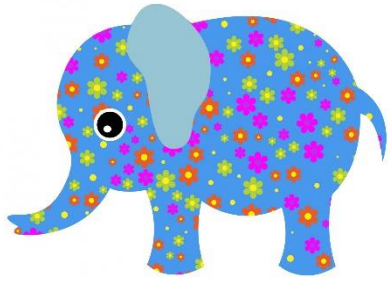

The next day, we'll have breakfast, load the bus at 9:00 a.m. and head to Old Port for some history and/or shopping. We'll head back to the Highlands around 1:00 p.m. and arrive about 5:30 p.m. The expectation here is that if you sign up you are GOING. The cost is \$240 per person, which covers transportation, hotel stay, breakfast on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, gratuities, games and a GREAT time with your Highlands' neighbors!
