IMPORTANT REMINDER

Effective July 1, 2026 the dues will increase from \$72.58 a month to \$78.00, a \$5.42 increase. The quarterly amount will be \$234, biannual \$468 and \$936 annually. If you have paid for the year, please be aware that you will owe \$32.52 more. For those of you that have arranged for your bank to send us a check, please notify your bank of this change.

The last week of May, 2026, FEMA announced that it approved funding to the Town of Oro Valley to upgrade The Highlands Wash. Thank you to Jim Coffee, Dave Freker and Lincoln Keilman for building a relationship with Oro Valley Storm Water by attending numerous meetings on this project.

In concert with The Highlands Storm Water Committee, in 2025 many members signed a petition which was sent to our Arizona governmental representatives in support of FEMA funding. The petition found a voice with Senator Mark Kelly who worked with FEMA in Washington DC to help secure the funds.

This clearly demonstrates that when we work together as a community good things can happen. Thanks to everyone who made this happen.

POOL USE: The pool will be padlocked from 9 PM to 7 AM starting June 10.

CLOSE THE POOL GATE WHEN IN USE:

Everyone asks 'why' and leaves the gate ajar for the next person. Well, there's a very good reason. The County does spot inspections, as we are a public pool. If a gate is found ajar, they can close us down for a period of time. Only you, being conscientious, can keep our pool open.

DOG ISSUE: The board is aware of issues with a couple of dog owners and are following a process to control that. Resident dogs have specific rules. If you find other dogs in the park (perhaps ranging from the new property developed above us), the best approach is: file a complaint with Pima Animal Care Center (PACC) by calling (520) 724-5900, ext. 4. They will take a complaint and if needed send somebody out or administer fines. They do prioritize cruelty cases, aggressive, and sick/injured strays. Issues regarding noise or waste you can address with a complaint form on <https://www.pima.gov/2578/Complaints>. You have to call within 48 hours.

KUDOS

THIS IS A REPEAT KUDO:

Two important items were purchased for our Clubhouse: an AED and a LifeVac system.

The Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device is life saving in case of a heart attack. A little fundamental knowledge is needed, but the device is self instructed once it is turned on. Someone usually has some fundamental knowledge while others call 911. Anyone can help save a life. This is mounted on the wall near the exit to the bathrooms. *Ron and Jeanie Wehl, Danny and Joyce Emory, John and Diane Pangburn, Philip Park and Paul Sakry, Tony and Lise Bettens, and Chuck and Chris Ardingo donated funds for this.*

The LIFEVAC SYSTEM - is a device to clear airways in the event of choking. That's on the wall in the back hallway. This works like a corrugated sink plunger - causing a vacuum to suck the obstacle out. *Purchased by Brian And Sheila Tomac*

ANOTHER KUDOS:

To Alicia and Linc - for updating, cleaning and organizing all of our street lights. They have 'dusk-to-dawn' bulbs now. Please DO NOT TRY TO REMOVE OR PAINT OVER BULBS OR OTHERWISE DISABLE. This has taken considerable time, and as Alicia says "the bulbs aren't cheap". If you find one out, please stop in to the office and fill out a maintenance form.
