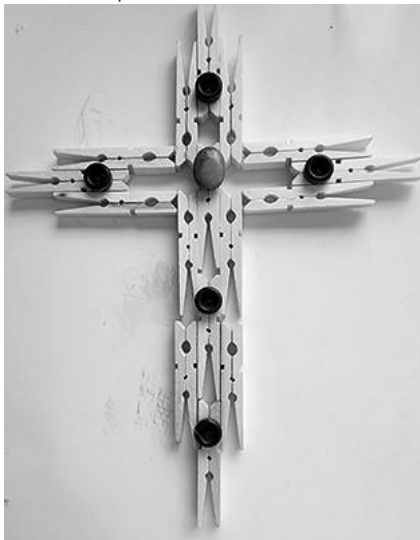

over some guidelines for the  
trash and recycle pick up.  
Acceptable RECYCLE for  
curb side pickup is as  
follows:

- \*Non-glossy paper
- \*Cardboard broken down  
flat (does not need to be  
bagged, but it does help us if  
it is tied up)

\*Aluminum cans (soda and  
soup cans)  
\*Number 1 plastic (water,  
soda, milk bottles) - All  
recycling except cardboard  
needs to be in a bag. This  
allows us to reduce wear and  
tear on your roads by only  
having to go through once to  
pick up trash and recycle at  
the same time. By bagging it,  
it allows us to separate it  
without it blowing everywhere  
in your community.

### **TRASH PICKUP:**

\*We have had some  
issues with people sharing  
service, this is NOT  
ACCEPTABLE. It is stealing  
and when we find the  
persons sharing, they will be  
cut off from our service. So  
please do not share service;  
we are a local company just  
trying to make a living.

\*The weekly amount of  
trash is 90 gallons worth. If  
you have more or bulky items  
that need to be picked up,  
please contact our office at  
520-883-5868 or speak with  
your driver.

\*All branches need to be  
bundled with rope, wire or  
twine into manageable  
bundles that we can pick up

\*We cannot pick up wet  
paint, tires, batteries,  
especially lithium they cause  
fires or anything that  
contained freon.

\*Please have all trash to  
the curb by 6 a.m.  
Again, thank you for your  
continued support of a local
